

Safe School Policy

Purpose

To ensure a safe and supportive virtual learning environment for all students, staff, and stakeholders of Royal Ontario Academy.

Policy

1. Respectful Communication

 All interactions within the virtual school environment must be conducted respectfully and courteously. Any form of bullying, harassment, or discrimination will not be tolerated.

2. Digital Citizenship

 Students and staff are expected to demonstrate responsible digital citizenship. This includes using technology in a safe, ethical, and respectful manner, protecting personal information, and respecting the privacy of others.

3. Academic Integrity

Academic honesty is a fundamental principle at Royal Ontario Academy.
Plagiarism, cheating, and any other forms of academic dishonesty are prohibited and will be subject to disciplinary action.

4. Online Behavior

Students and staff must adhere to the code of conduct for online behavior.
This includes not engaging in cyberbullying, sending inappropriate messages, or sharing harmful content.

5. Secure Learning Environment
