Educational Use Only

- The LMS and all related tools and resources are to be used strictly for educational purposes. Any use outside of this scope is considered inappropriate.
- Inappropriate uses of the LMS include, but are not limited to:
 - Criminal activities
 - Obscene content
 - Commercial purposes
 - Illegal activities

Review and Consequences

- The administration reserves the right to review all student work to determine the appropriateness of computer use.
- If the LMS is deemed to be used inappropriately, the administration will impose consequences, which may include suspensions and/or removal from the program. In severe cases, further action may be taken, including contacting day schools, legal representation, or the police.

Student Vigilance

- Students must be vigilant to prevent situations where they might be suspected of inappropriate use.
- Students are reminded to:
 - Always protect their passwords and not share them with anyone.
 - Always inform their teachers of suspicious messages or other incidents that they encounter.
 - Always access only content intended for student use.

Implementation

- The Principal and staff of Royal Ontario Academy are responsible for implementing and enforcing this Appropriate Computer Use Policy.

All members of the school community are expected to adhere to this policy to maintain a positive and secure virtual learning environment.
